- Invite and encourage friends and family to purchase tickets to Young Voices Toronto concerts and fundraising events.
- Provide tuition payment by full payment through the Young Voices Toronto website, post-dated cheques or via direct debit agreement at the beginning of the term. I understand that paying on time is my responsibility and payment reminders will not be sent. **If I miss a payment, I agree to pay a late fee of \$10/month.**

# Parental Consent, Release & Waiver

- Carefully observe the performance dress code for each choir event.
- Practice singing for a minimum of 15 minutes each day

## REFUND & RESIGNATION POLICY

Before resigning, we welcome you to speak directly with the general manager. It is always our first priority to try to resolve any concerns you may have. If, however, you make the decision to leave Young Voices Toronto before the end of the 2018/19 choral season, please apply the following.

- ❑ **A chorister resigning at any time for any reason must complete an official Young Voices Toronto Resignation Form.** A resignation form can be obtained from the general manager in person or via email at [manager@youngvoicestoronto.com](mailto:manager@youngvoicestoronto.com)
- ❑ Young Voices Toronto relies on registration fees to maintain the high-quality programming for which it has become known. With that in mind, **refunds on registration fees are not available.** The only exceptions are as follows:
  - ❑ Choristers who start in September, if the resignation is received prior to October 15 (for all choirs except Encore). Encore resignation must be received prior to September 28.
  - ❑ Choristers who start in January, if the resignation is received prior to February 15 (for all choirs except Encore). Encore resignation must be received prior to January 25.
- ❑ The date of the resignation will be the date on which the resignation notice or form is received.
